

## SWIMMING POOL FILLING WAIVER

In the event a customer of Public Service Authority (PSA) water and Fairlawn Sewer Authority (FSA) sewerage services is using water from PSA for filling of a private swimming pool, the user may ask the FSA Board for all or part of the water being used to be exempted from his or her FSA bill.

In order to qualify for a usage credit, a written request for a waiver to include the physical dimensions of the pool must be submitted to the FSA Board for consideration. The written request is to be delivered to the Fairlawn Bookkeeping and Tax Service who will forward the request directly to the Board. The submission must be provided within forty-five (45) days of the actual water consumption.

Estimation of the water used to fill the pool will not be accepted. The FSA Board will use commercially published volumes for the pool size in question to establish the actual amount of the credit. THE SUBMISSION MUST INCLUDE A STATEMENT OF HOW ANY OR ALL OF THE WATER DRAINED FROM THE POOL IS DISPERSED. IF THE POOL IS DRAINED INTO AN OPEN MANHOLE OR INTO THE FSA SEWER SYSTEM, NO WAIVER WILL BE ACCEPTED.
